SUMMARY

Enrollment

- Present the campaign to your class or church.
- Call to order the desired number of baby bottles for your group.
- Place bottles in homes.
- Deposit loose change into the bottles.

Placement

- Participants take bottles home and deposit loose change or bills into the bottles.

Promotion

- Advertise in Bulletins.
- Give Announcements.

Collection

- Collect the bottles of change.
- Your Organization donates the collected change to Hannah's House.
- Call us to make arrangements for us to pick up the bottles. We will count the change for you and will present your group with a certificate of appreciation.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS !

We will deliver the amount of Baby Bottles you request.

Please distribute the bottles to your class or congregation, and make an announcement from the pulpit, in your bulletin, or newsletter to encourage people to take a bottle home.

At HOME, put the bottle in a visible place as a reminder to pray for the safety and salvation of mothers and their pre-born children. Then, as God leads you, put your pocket change and bills in the bottle as an offering to help Hannah's moms.

At CHURCH, please collect the bottles. Announcements should be made to remind people about the collection.

We have found the formula for success! Please consider taking home a Baby Bottle to fill with your loose change and prayers for the ministry of Hannah's House. The bottles should be returned by....

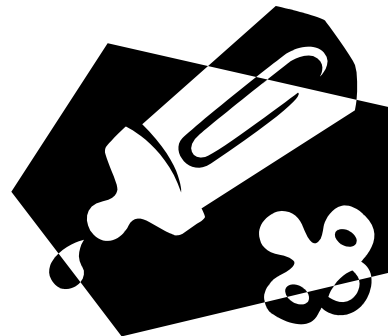
HANNAH'S HOUSE

Hannah's House is a non-denominational Christian Maternity home, offering expectant mothers a safe, comfortable and loving home. We serve expectant mothers by providing many of the essential services they need to become healthy, successful parents: from basic needs such as housing, clothing, and nutrition to parenting and life skills education. Women stay free of charge at Hannah's House through pregnancy and up to nine months after the birth of the child.

Research by Lillian Gelberg, M.D., M.S.P.H. finds that "homelessness leads to lower birthweight (LBW) and preterm babies, who are at increased risk of dying or having long-term neurodevelopmental and respiratory disorders. Long and frequent periods of chronic homelessness had an even stronger impact on adverse birth outcomes than homelessness during the first trimester of pregnancy. The resulting poor birth outcomes may have been due to inadequate nutrition and general neglect of health during homeless times, as well as chronically stressful and devastating life circumstances, explain the researchers. They conclude that prenatal care alone cannot be expected to reverse the cumulative and weathering effects of chronic homelessness on the reproductive health of homeless women."
