Hannah's House is in the business of fostering mothers. We teach young women who have fallen on hard times how to let God help them become the kind of mothers whose children will "rise up and call them blessed." We consider it our privilege and our mission--with God's help--to raise up mothers who respect themselves, respect the little ones they've been entrusted with, and who turn to our Creator to help them raise their children.

We accomplish our mission by teaching life skills to the young women who come to live at Hannah's House. We also teach parenting skills so that they can get a feel for what it means to be a good mother. But most of all we provide them with examples of what a good mother does in the form of our housemothers.

Our housemothers, or house managers, are responsible for the day to day running of Hannah's House. They are constantly available to speak into the lives of our residents, and they interact with them in a variety of situations. They provide our young women with examples to emulate in spirituality and lifestyle, and they learn how to treat others by observing how the housemothers interact with others.

We currently have one full-time housemother and one substitute housemother. Our full-time house manager is Evelyn Malcolm, mother of five and grandmother to 16. Evelyn's grandchildren are frequent visitors at Hannah's House, and the patience and loving kindness she shows to them is unspoken encouragement for our residents to treat their babies the same way.

Our substitute housemother is Barbara Armstrong, mother of nine. Barbara was formerly the full-time house manager at Hannah's House for many years, and her strong faith and willingness to share it is a blessing to our residents.

At this point in time, we are looking for another substitute housemother to work alternate weekends

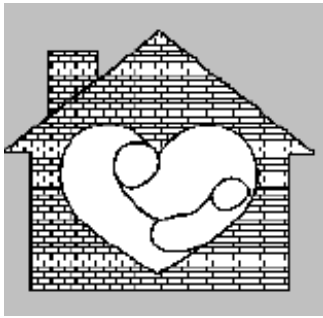
We need a deeply committed Christian woman of good character who can show Christian love and act as a shepherd to the women God brings into His house.
