



VISITATION POLICIES

1. Parents will be allowed to visit their daughter with the understanding that they will notify the House Manager twenty-four (24) hours in advance and work out arrangements for the visit.
2. All visitors, including other relatives and or friends, must be interviewed and approved by the House Manager or staff prior to the visit. All visitations must be arranged in advance with the House Manager. Visitors must provide a copy of their current Driver's License or ID.
3. Boyfriends will not be allowed to be in the Home unless the House Manager is present. Dating will be regulated and arranged according to individual situations and staff approval.
4. The baby's Father will be allowed to visit at the discretion of the House Manager. Visits are twice a week and arranged with the House Manger ahead of time.
5. Resident will be allowed to go out with friends, relatives, and parents with the approval of the House Manger.
6. Once a resident reaches the eighth (8) month of her pregnancy, she is considered homebound until the birth of her child and through post-partum (6 weeks after delivery). This means no overnight visits during this period. Also while on homebound, the resident cannot be away from the home without staff for longer than three (3) hours.
7. Home visits will be arranged by the House Manager. Residents are allowed two (2) home visits a month. A resident must have been at Hannah's for three (3) weeks to be eligible for home visits. Once arrangements have been made for home visits, **THEY CAN NOT BE CHANGED** in the middle of the visit except for extreme circumstances.
8. Staff/House manager will follow up on home visits and further visits will be arranged accordingly.

I understand and will comply with these policies. If I choose not to adhere to the above mentioned, I am fully aware I will be restricted from Hannah's House and their residents at any time by any staff member. These policies are subject to change at the discretion of the House parent or staff.
