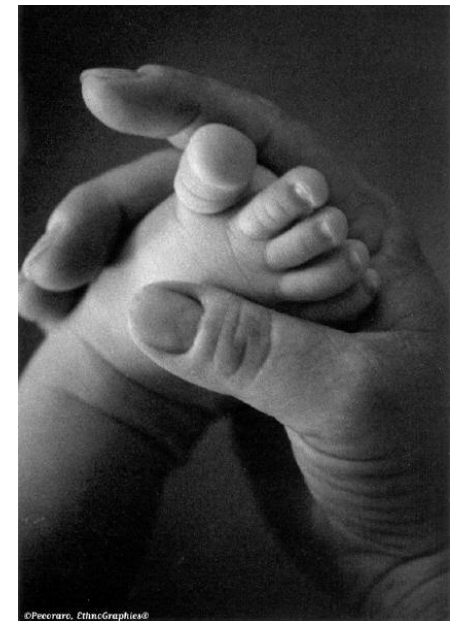
Our Mission Statement

Working With Residents

Friend/Mentor:

Responsibilities: Develop a friendship with residents. Plan outings and fun activities. Provide a support system for resident.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, on-the-job training, working one 2-hour shift weekly with a one year commitment. Must be a pro-life, Christian.

Craft Teacher:

Responsibilities: Teach a craft or hobby.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview.

Cooking Instructor:

Responsibilities: Share cooking or baking projects with women.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, individual who enjoys cooking and/or baking.

Budget Instructor:

Responsibilities: Help women set up and follow a simple budget. Encourage women to open a savings account, and instruct them in general banking.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, working one 2-hour shift bi-weekly with a one year commitment.

Employment Skills Instructor:

Responsibilities: Teach employment seeking, résumé building, and interviewing skills.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, working one 2-hour shift bi-weekly with a one year commitment.

Prenatal Instructor:

Responsibilities: Provide pre-natal & childbirth instruction.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview. Experience or certification in pre-natal instruction or a duealla license. Interest in sharing your experience and guidance with our mothers.

Parenting Instructor:

Responsibilities: Provide instruction on positive parenting.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, on-the-job training, working one 2-hour shift bi-weekly with a one year commitment. Interested in sharing your experience and guidance with our mothers.



Working Behind the Scenes

Donations Assistant:

Responsibilities: Sort and organize donations, fold baby clothing, compile layettes.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, on-the-job training, working one 2-hour shift bi-weekly.

Mailing Team:

Responsibilities: Assemble, stuff, and label a Bi-monthly newsletter.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, on-the-job training, working 4 hours bi-monthly. Dates and times are scheduled by the director.

Prayer Team:

Responsibilities: Pray for residents, staff, ministry, and volunteer needs.

Requirements: Application, two personal references, interview, willingness to petition God and be committed to praying for the ministry 2 hours once or twice each month.

Maintenance:

Responsibilities: Do light maintenance, cleaning, yard work, simple repairs, and occasional moving, lifting and hauling.

Requirements: Application, interview, work 2 hours once or twice a month.

Group Projects:

Occasionally we need groups of 8 - 15 people for major projects. These jobs may be scheduled ahead of time with the director.

Groups can also help by doing projects on their own such as collecting baby items, donating funds, or doing a fundraising project like our Save-A-Life Baby Bottle Club.

Hannah's House holds a fundraising Banquet in the Spring and a Walk-a-thon in the Fall. Groups can help us prepare for these events and participate on the days of the events. Call the office to offer your group's help.
